

Duke University's History Union is seeking paper submissions from exceptional undergraduate students from distinguished institutions such as Harvard University for the inaugural issue of its historical review journal, *Historia Nova*. If you could please forward this email to your university's undergraduate history mailing list, it would be greatly appreciated.

We are considering paper submissions which meet the following criterion:

- Papers submitted for consideration with *Historia Nova* cannot have been published in any other historical review or publication.
- Papers must center on a historically-relevant topic that is of interest and contributes to broader historical analysis.
- Paper submissions can be accompanied by a professor recommendation, but are not required to do so.
- Paper submissions are not limited to those written for an undergraduate course and can have been written outside of undergraduate course work, as long as it meets other submission criteria.
- Paper length may range from 10 to 30 double-spaced pages in length with size 12 Times New Roman font, but in certain exceptional circumstances, papers exceeding 30 pages may be abridged if chosen for publication.

If you are aware of or would like to recommend a student to submit his or her historical paper for publication, please note the following requirements for submission:

- Submissions must be sent via email to dukehistorianova@gmail.com by **January 15th** with "Submission," followed by the student's name in the subject line.
- Submission emails must include in the body of the email: student name, undergraduate institution, current year of undergraduate study, date on which paper was submitted for undergraduate course, undergraduate course name and professor for which paper was written, course grade received (if applicable) and a brief summary (not exceeding five sentences) of the submitted paper.
- Submission emails must include either a PDF or Microsoft Word document file of the paper ***without the student or institution name*** on the paper itself.

All papers will be reviewed by a committee of Duke professors, graduate history students, and the editors of *Historia Nova*. Students will be informed of their paper's status on **February 12th**, but may be contacted for inquiries regarding their submission before that date.

We, along with the executive team of Duke's Historical Union, thank you in advance for your support in encouraging qualified undergraduate students at your institution to submit their insightful historical papers for publication in our inaugural issue.
