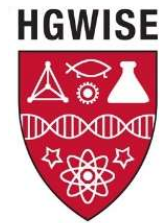
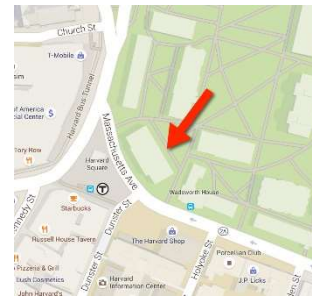


Lunch and discussion with Dean Emma Dench

What: Born and raised in the UK, Emma appeared in the 1968 film version of *A Midsummer Night's Dream* as Peaseblossom alongside her aunt, Judi Dench. She went on to earn her BA and MA from the University of Oxford. Before joining Harvard faculty in January 2007, she taught classics and ancient history at University of London. She has been a Craven Fellow at the University of Oxford, a Rome Scholar and a Hugh Last Fellow at the British School of Rome, a Cotton Fellow, a Member of the School of Historical Studies at Princeton, and a Loeb Classical Library Foundation Fellow. As a faculty at Harvard, Emma has received numerous awards including "Outstanding Contributions to Undergraduate Teaching, Mentoring and Advising", Marquand Award for Excellent Advising and Counseling, and Everett Mendelsohn Award for Excellence in Mentoring Graduate Students.
