# *Theodosian Harbor Excavations* **AND 37 BYZANTINE SHIPWRECKS** *at Yenikapı in Istanbul, Turkey*

Salvage excavations at Yenikapı in Istanbul, Turkey, have unearthed in the Theodosian Harbor the largest collection of medieval ships ever uncovered at an excavation site – 37 ships from the 5th to 11th century CE.

Prof. Kocabaş, who directs “The Yenikapı shipwrecks Project,” will present new findings on shipbuilding traditions and techniques in the Mediterranean region.
